## RATE BILL

At a meeting of the Board of Estimate and Taxation of the City of Norwalk, Connecticut, legally warned and held on the 2nd day of May 2011, it was voted to lay a tax on the grand list of October 1, 2010, at the following composite mill rates:

Districts 1, 2, 3, 8 and 9: 20.742 mills on the dollar;  
District 4: 20.795 mills on the dollar;  
District 5: 20.304 mills on the dollar;  
Districts 6 and 7: 19.022 mills on the dollar;


said taxes to become due and payable one half on or before the first day of July, 2011, and the balance on or before the first day of January, 2012; and,


District 10: 25.448 mills on the dollar;

said taxes to become due and payable on or before the first day of July, 2011, and said supplemental taxes to become due and payable on or before the first day of January, 2012.




