Dear Mr. Forrest:

The Housing Authority of the City of Norwalk is applying for a Choice Neighborhoods Implementation Grant from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The proposed project consists of the demolition and new construction of the existing public housing development known as Washington Village at Raymond and Day Streets, South Norwalk, Connecticut. We are compiling background information on whether the existing public housing on the site may be eligible for the National Register of Historic Places.

Attached are photographs of the property and a location map. The current development was constructed in 1940. The buildings over the years have not been altered except for the elimination of the central heating plant and the addition of building boilers along with the installation of pitched roofs. The Housing Authority is not aware of any historic or architectural significance. According to our file search, it is not listed on the National Register or State of Connecticut register. Can you please advise us if SHPO would consider Washington Village as meeting any National Register criteria?

Additionally, can you please inform us if any known archeological sites have been identified at this location?


