1 Jennings Place, Applicant Water Sorts Center, Inc; 35 Seaview Ave: Relocation of docking facilities for Maritime Rowing Club. The new facility will be re-located from adjacent to the Walk RR Bridge upstream to 1 Jennings Place. The Applicant seeks to install a 240'x18' floating dock to act as a rowing platform. The float will be accessed by two 33'x 8' access gangways and two 30'x 10' fixed timber piers. The timber piers will span over the existing revetment structure. The floating dock will be anchored using Seaflex™ anchors in accordance with the manufacture's requirements.

Maintenance Dredging, Village Creek; Applicant Village Creek Harbor Corporation; Maintenance dredging of the mooring basin and channel will involve removal of 24,900 cy of sediment. Docks and pilings will be temporarily relocated. One foot overdredge is proposed in each section. Mechanical dredging will utilize a barge crane equipped with a clamshell bucket or hydraulic excavator. Disposal of dredged material at Western LIS (WLIS) disposal area will require final confirmation by DEEP.
