AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH DOMUS CONSTRUCTORS LLC, FOR ROOF REPAIRS ON THE LOCKWOOD MATHEWS MANSION IN THE AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$167,400. ACCOUNTS 09176310 5777 C0092 and 09186310 5777 C0092.

 - B. Approve and refer the following change to the Ordinance Committee of the Common Council:
Chapter 55 Demolition Delay, 55-3 Application Procedure, Paragraph C:

In the event that a written, acknowledged objection, stating the reasons for opposing demolition is filed with the Chief Building Official within 21 days after filing the certification statement as required by § 55-3, above, the Chief Building Official shall not issue the permit until ~~120~~ 180 days after the application is deemed filed. If no such written objection is filed, the Chief Building Official may issue the demolition permit, provided that all other requirements have been complied with.
