 1. **Calf Pasture Island, Notice of Tentative Determination to Approve (Coastal Permit #20160709)**. The applicant, Robert Nowinski, plans to modify an existing dock by installing a 4' x 9' aluminum ramp, four 5' x 25' timber floating docks hinged together with float stops and anchored by 8 timber float restraint piles.
 2. **5 Decker Road, Notice of Tentative Determination to Approve (Application no. 20173497- SDFTW)**, The applicants, Thomas and Allison Robbins, propose to renovate and add to their existing residence structures. Work includes demolition of existing garage, partial demolition with renovation and addition to current residence. Improvements include increases to impervious surfaces (~737 sq ft) and improved drainage of roof runoff approximately equal to increase area of impervious surface via use of rain garden. The applicant plans to enhance water access by constructing a pier and deck with Norwalk Harbor. Pier and Deck permit is pending with the CT DEEP and is not a part of this CAM application.
 3. **Walk Bridge Project, Notice of Availability-Finding of No Significant Impact**. An Environmental Assessment/Environmental Impact Evaluation was prepared for the Walk Bridge Replacement Project in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the Connecticut Environmental Policy Act (CEPA) in August 2016. On July 17th 2017, the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) has issued a finding of no significant impact for the project in compliance with NEPA. In short, the FTA has determined that an Environmental Impact Statement is not required for the Walk Project and will not be prepared. In addition, in June 2017, a Record of Decision (ROD) was submitted to the CT Office of Policy and Management (OPM) and in a letter dated July 6, 2017, OPM determined that the EA/EIE and ROD satisfy requirements of CEPA for the project.
