**CT DOT PRESENTATION**

CT DOT representatives discussed the Test Pile Program slated for the summer of 2018. In addition, the CT DOT representatives provided an overview of the water related activities needed prior to the actual WALK Bridge replacement Discussion followed on the Coastwise Marina piles that need to be pulled and a current status the WALK Bridge project. Questions were fielded throughout the presentation.

**APPLICATION**

**2. 44 Shorehaven Road CAM Application**

Attorney Elizabeth Suchy stated that the applicant proposes to demolish the existing structure and re-construct a single family residence with attached garage and other site improvements within a flood zone. The property is split between the City of Norwalk and the town of Westport. She stated that storm water from the residence, pool house and driveway will be collected and piped to underground infiltrators in the southwestern corner of the site (Norwalk Sector).

Mr. Andy Soumelidis stated that imperious surface area will be reduced by 406 sq. ft. Water runoff in the rear portion of the property will continue to sheet flow over lawn areas and into Long Island Sound.

Dr. Pinto stated that the plans are consistent with the Harbor Management Plan. He stated that the committee will recommend that the full commission approve the application.
