1. **Vantage Point Condominium COP application.** The applicant, Vantage Point Association, Inc., proposes to replace an existing stormwater discharge pipe leading to Norwalk Harbor. The new 15" High Density Polyethylene Pipe will exit the bulkhead at the same location and invert as the existing pipe. The new pipe has been reconfigured to avoid the existing pool patio and simplify construction. A hydrodynamic separator will be added inland of the Coastal Jurisdiction Limit and has been sized to treat the water quality flow from the site runoff. There are currently no stormwater treatment mechanisms on the site. Silt sacks will be used in catch basins to filter runoff during construction. Two hydrodynamic separators will be installed to collect stormwater runoff which will improve the water quality in Norwalk Harbor than what is currently present.
2. **Walk Bridge Project:** Discussion in preparation of CTDOT meeting. Christopher W. Samorajczyk, Wildlife Biologist, and other members of CTDOT plan to present the full WALK Bridge project at the Commission's October 24th meeting.
3. **Eversource Transmission line relocation proposal.** Discussion of new pre-application proposal by Eversource for relocating two 115 kV powerlines under Norwalk Harbor. Need letter and information to meet with common council members
