CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Rilling called the meeting to order at 4:00 p. m. A quorum was present.

BUSINESS

1. Approve the minutes of the special meeting of Tuesday, September 25, 2018.

- ** **COMMISSIONER COLLIER-CLEMMONS MOVED TO APPROVE THE SEPTEMBER 25, 2018 MINUTES AS AMENDED.**

2. Approve the installation of a crosswalk on Gregory Boulevard at Elliott Street.

Mr. Eshraghi stated that a traffic study has been conducted for installation of a pedestrian crosswalk at this location. To provide a safer environment for pedestrian crossing at the intersection, we recommend the installation of crosswalks.

- ** **COMMISSIONER YOST MOVED TO APPROVE THE INSTALLATION OF A CROSSWALK ON GREGORY BOULEVARD AT ELLIOTT STREET.**

3. Approve extending the temporary traffic diversion plan on Pine Street Extension from November 16, 2018 until January 31, 2019.

4. Approve the road closure plan for the Rowayton Civic Association Light Up Rowayton event to be held on November 25, 2018.

- ** THE MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.

5. Concur with the State's determination that no public informational meeting nor public hearing is needed for installing curve warning signs and pavement markings on State roads in Norwalk under State Project 0173-0485.

- ** COMMISSIONER COLLIER-CLEMMONS MOVED TO CONCUR WITH THE STATE'S DETERMINATION THAT NO PUBLIC INFORMATIONAL MEETING NOR PUBLIC HEARING IS NEEDED FOR INSTALLING CURVE WARNING SIGNS AND PAVEMENT MARKINGS ON STATE ROADS IN NORWALK UNDER STATE PROJECT 0173-0485.
- ** THE MOTION PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.
