WHEREAS, the Norwalk CT Common Council has considered Norwalk City staff is considering the concerns of residents from public informational meetings and the Norwalk Common Council finds that the proposed project, Reconstruction of Rowayton Avenue at Metro North Railroad Bridge No. 4132R (ConnDOT Project No. 102-H065) is in the best interest of the City of Norwalk, CT and will promote the health, safety and general welfare of its residents and provide for the convenience and safety of the motoring public and pedestrian traffic.
