1. 2009-13: Richard Scalise, Jr, 15 Seabreeze Place, Norwalk

DEP Application for work at a private residence to construct a pile-supported pier 4' x approximately 50' with a 10' x 10 piling supported pierhead that anchors a 13' extension of a boat elevator. The elevator will support a vessel with a beam of 7'; in its lowered position there will be 2' clearance above the substrate. The proposal also includes 4' wide timber steps leading landward from the existing seawall. Deck elevation on the pier will be +12.5'. Total waterward encroachment will be approximately 73'. The proposal also requests retention of an existing, pre-1980 concrete seawall 5' high x 1' thick x 147 linear feet.

Comments have been received from the Shellfish Commission.

1. CT DEP Notice of Tentative Determination to Approve an application by Connecticut Light and Power.

Proposed work will be along the banks of the Norwalk River, north of New Canaan Avenue, to install 8,200 sq. feet of riprap for erosion control. The proposed work was designed by Leonard Jackson Associates, professional engineers; the draft permit indicates no special conditions.
