## 1. 2009-10 (Revised): David Woodward, 16 Tonetta Circle, East Norwalk

CT DEP #200802445-SJ Notice of Tentative Determination to approve the revised application (plans dated 8/03/09, prepared by Roberge Associates). The proposal is to retain and maintain a seawall and install a dock, ramp, and boat lift at a private residence. The total encroachment is shown at 52'; the pile supported timber pier is 4' x 24'; aluminum 3' x 18' ramp leading to a 10' x 10 floating dock. There will also be six pilings utilizing lift stops to keep the float and vessels 18" off the bottom; the six pilings support two boat lifts. The original proposal was tabled in March 2009.

The Bureau of Aquaculture has determined that this activity will not significantly impact any shellfish area. The Norwalk Shellfish Commission has issued lengthy written comments to CT DEP OLISP with strong objections to this proposal.

## 2. 2009-09 (Revised): Anthony and Elise Tomas, 18 Tonetta Circle, East Norwalk

CT DEP # 2008443-SJ. Proposal for work at private residence adjoining the Woodward property; drawings prepared by Roberge Associates revised 7-07-09 include the removal of an existing deck; installation of a 4 x 18' pile-supported timber pier; 3' x 24' aluminum gangway leading to a 10' x 10' floating dock and six timber pilings with float stops at 18" above the bottom. The six pilings also support two boat/float lifts. Total encroachment is 50' 3".

The proposal has not yet gone to public notice, pending a meeting between DEP OLISP and the Norwalk Shellfish Commission the week of Sept. 14. Originally reviewed by NHMC and tabled in March 2009.
