PERMITS

Passenger Vehicles (Cars & SUVs): Must have a valid Resident/Beach Pass <u>visible on the windshield.</u>

Non-Commercial Pick-Up Trucks, Vans, and Vehicles with Trailers: Must have a Residential Permit Cards, which are available at the Transfer Station.

Trucks, pickups, vans and vehicles with trailers will be weighed at all times.

Commercial Vehicles: Must have proper Commercial Permits. Call 203-854-3241 for information.

If the vehicle does not have a proper permit: There is a minimum charge of \$20. Disposal costs can increase.

Acceptable Items for DISPOSAL

- Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) or Garbage
- Bulky items (furniture, carpet, mattress, etc.)
- Dimensional wood and wooden items (4 feet or smaller)
- Latex paint (dried & solid only)

Acceptable Items for RECYCLING

Cardboard Compactor

Single Stream Compactor

Rigid Plastic Container

Large plastic Items, toys, laundry baskets

Used Cooking Oil Container

Electronic Waste Container

TVs, computer monitor & tower, printer, etc.

Used Oil/ Antifreeze (See DPW Fee Schedule)

Used Motor Oil: 5 gallon max per day Used Antifreeze: 5 gallon max per day

Oil Filters: 3 filters max per day

Batteries (See DPW Fee Schedule)

Lithium batteries

Vehicle batteries/ lead acid

Alkaline batteries (e.g. AA, C, D, etc.)

Freon Appliances (See DPW Fee Schedule)

Refrigerators, Freezers, Air Conditioners, Dehumidifiers: 3 appliances max per day

Tires (See DPW Fee Schedule)
All Tires (Car/ Truck)

Metal

Large metal items & appliances – Mixed Metal, Aluminum, Copper & Wire

Propane Tanks

Less than 50 lbs: See DPW Fee Schedule

Textile Container

Gently used clothing and shoes

NOT ACCEPTABLE Items

- Ammunition or Explosives
- Asbestos-containing materials
- Asphalt Shingles & Sheetrock
- Brick, block, cement or asphalt rubble
- Ceramic items (sinks, toilets, tile)
- Construction & Demolition Debris
- Counter Tops (Corian, Laminate, etc)
- Wet Paint
- Fluorescent bulbs: CFL or Tube (Home Depot & Lowes will accept unbroken bulbs)
- Hazardous Materials: Please ask for Household Hazardous Waste Day Flyer
