## **YARD WASTE COLLECTION SCHEDULE**

Residents of the 4<sup>th</sup> Taxing District that receive City garbage collection are entitled to receive Yard Waste Collection.

Residents are asked to have their Christmas Trees and Yard Waste curbside before 6:00 AM on the Monday of their scheduled collection week.

### **2021 Yard Waste Collection**

Residents of the 4<sup>th</sup> Taxing District **are required** to have their Yard Waste curbside at 6:00 AM on the **MONDAY** of the scheduled week of pickup, as the truck will pass by only once during that week. Once the truck passes it will **NOT** return until the 2nd scheduled collection (Fall **ONLY**). The Yard Waste collection schedule is as follows:

Week of April 5: Mon, Tues and Wed routes  
Week of April 12: Thursday and Friday routes

Week of May 3: Mon, Tues and Wed routes  
Week of May 10: Thursday and Friday routes

Week of Nov. 8: Mon, Tues and Wed routes  
Week of Nov. 15: Thursday and Friday routes

Week of Nov. 29: Mon, Tues and Wed routes  
Week of Dec. 6: Thursday and Friday routes

### **2022 Christmas Tree Collection**

Christmas Trees will be collected during January 2022:

Week of January 3, 2022  
Week of January 10, 2022

**NO PLASTIC BAGS, LIGHTS OR DECORATIONS.**

## **YARD WASTE COLLECTION GUIDELINES**

Leaves, brush and grass clippings are on Connecticut's list of mandatory recycling items. **PLEASE DO NOT MIX THESE ITEMS WITH GARBAGE.**

The City of Norwalk encourages you to compost at home and mulch your grass clippings into your lawn.

Yard waste collection guidelines are as follows:

1. **Curbside by 6:00 AM on the MONDAY of your listed yard waste collection week.**
2. **Leaves** will be collected **ONLY** in brown paper leaf bags, garbage cans with no lids, or open-top cardboard boxes.
3. **Brush** must be less than 4 feet in length and 6 inches or less in diameter. It must be tied up in bundles, no heavier than 50 lbs or in garbage cans with no lids.
4. Plastic bags, loose piles of brush and leaves, rocks, soil, and sand **WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.**
5. There is a 25-pound weight limit for bags and a 50-pound limit for cans – **Please do not overload bags and cans.**
6. Logs and stumps **WILL NOT BE COLLECTED.** They can be brought to the Yard Waste Site located at 15 South Smith Street.
7. If you believe you are missed for a yard waste pickup, please call Customer Service on **Monday** of the following week.
