



6. **Kingdom Hall of Jehovah's Witness – 126 Newtown Avenue - #3-00SP - approved 4/12/00**  
8,300+ sq.ft. new one-story building – parking required – 72, provided 102; ratio of 1 space per 5 seats applied  
Saturday evening service; Sunday morning, afternoon, late afternoon services  
Weekday evening services
7. **St. Peter's Lutheran Church – 208 Newtown Avenue - #6-99SP – approved 3/19/99**  
Convert classrooms to day care center on lower level  
Worship hall – 220-seat capacity required 55 parking spaces; ratio of 1 space to 5 seats applied; 93 spaces existing  
Sunday morning services, Bible study
8. **Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji Foundation gurudwara – 622 West Avenue Zoning Permit 1997**  
665 sq.ft. = 95-person capacity (place of assembly since no seating plan submitted) 19 spaces required; ratio of 1 space per 5 seats, 24 provided  
Inner sanctum, restroom, coatroom, entrance, community call, vault, remainder of building – all excluded from parking calculation  
Sunday morning service followed by lunch; Friday evening service pre-Covid; April 14 celebration
9. **Lighthouse Baptist Church – 4 Bayne Street**  
Existing 2,025 sq.ft., one-story church  
Addition of 9,100 sq. ft, proposed in 1996 - withdrawn  
Maximum seating capacity - 400; Parking required: 80 spaces required; ratio of based 1 space per 5 seats applied.  
Sunday services; weekday prayer service
10. **United Church of Rowayton – 210 Rowayton Avenue - #21-95SP/#22-95CAM - 1995**  
331 seats in church; 66 spaces required - ratio of 1 parking space per 5 seats applied; 110 provided  
7,487 sf addition (new meeting house) – no additional parking required because no increase in occupancy  
Sanctuary – 5,300 sf – 1<sup>st</sup> floor, 5,300 sf – 2<sup>nd</sup> floor  
Meeting house – 4,856 sf – 1<sup>st</sup> floor, 1,726 sf – 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, 1,292 sf – basement  
Sunday morning services and other events
11. **Congregation Beth-El - East Avenue – #24-86SP – approved 6/17/86**  
5,050+ sq.ft. addition (north side – multi-purpose hall & kitchen facilities; west side – new foyer, interior renovations)  
Addition created 56 more seats in worship area, requiring 12 more parking spaces  
1 parking space to 5 seats ratio applied  
Sabbath and other holy services  
Nursery school, religious school, youth programs
12. **Temple Shalom 259 Richards Avenue 13,982 sf - 1985 addition**  
174 seats in sanctuary required 35 parking spaces; ratio of 1 space per 5 seats applied  
Onsite parking - 35 spaces  
Sabbath and other holy services

Maximum seating capacity – 875; 175 spaces required; ratio of 1 space per 5 seats applied  
Sunday and weekday services, bible study; day care center

**14. Beth Israel Chabad of Norwalk/Westport – King Street**

Mikvah facility – parking based on ratio of 1 space per 5 seats applied

**15. United Congregational Church (formerly United Church of West Norwalk) Richards Avenue**

Original plans:  
4,575 sq.ft. basement  
4,575 sq.ft. main floor  
Permit showed 61 parking spaces required  
Sunday worship services, holy days

Subsequent plans showed 2,800 sq.ft. 1<sup>st</sup> floor; 2,800 sq.ft. lower floor; 2,800 sq.ft. cathedral
